Check your Eligibility

- Minimum of a Bachelor's degree in any field of study
Exceptions may be made for those with 3 or more years of experience in a medical or allied health field such as medicine, nursing, physical therapy, health education, exercise physiology, psychotherapy, or nutrition.

Apply

- Prepare your application. You will need to be ready to upload or enter:
 - Resume or CV
 - Statement of Purpose
 - Statement describing what aspect of Health & Well-Being Coaching you are most interested in.
- [Submit Application online](#). Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, however, it is **preferred to receive 4 weeks prior to early registration deadline**.
- You will receive notification of acceptance decision via email.
 - If accepted, continue below.
